- Consequences for retailers (if fireworks are sold to under 18s)
- Useful Advice (incorporating Do's & Don'ts)

Additionally, West Yorkshire Fire and Rescue has delivered a session face to face to a group of Years 7, 8 and 9 students on bonfire basics, firework facts and anti-social behaviour impact.
