Dear Parent/Carer,

Our Year 11 students have been working extremely hard to ensure they are fully prepared for the start of the formal exam season on Monday 16th May. This is a crucial time for students so every effort from staff, students and parents/carers is needed for them to succeed.

- Students will be in the academy full time until the end of Tuesday 21 June. During this time students will follow their normal timetable but we have ensured that students will receive a Masterclass the day before any core subject exam.
- Wednesday 22nd June will be a study from home day where a live physics Masterclass will be available online between 10:00 and 11:00am. Students who have a Music exam in the morning will need to arrive at school at 8:20. Students who have a Further Maths exam will need to arrive at school at 12:30pm and sign in at SID
- Thursday 23 June is the last major exam for all students. Students will need to be in their tutor rooms for 8:20am. Once the exam has finished, students will be taken to an area where they will be able to sign shirts before leaving site at approximately 11am so they can prepare for the Year 11 Prom.
- Thursday 23 June is the last day students will need to attend and is their official leaving date.

It is important that students attend all their lessons, Masterclasses and actual exams during this time.

We will be registering students in their normal tutor rooms at 8:20am from Monday 16th May in order to make sure we have enough time to register, give the students any pre exam advice/pep talk and then load into the exam halls for a prompt 9:00am start. It is very important that students are on time so they can be fully prepared.

Some subjects will run breakfast revision sessions, students will be told by subject staff when these will run and when to attend.
