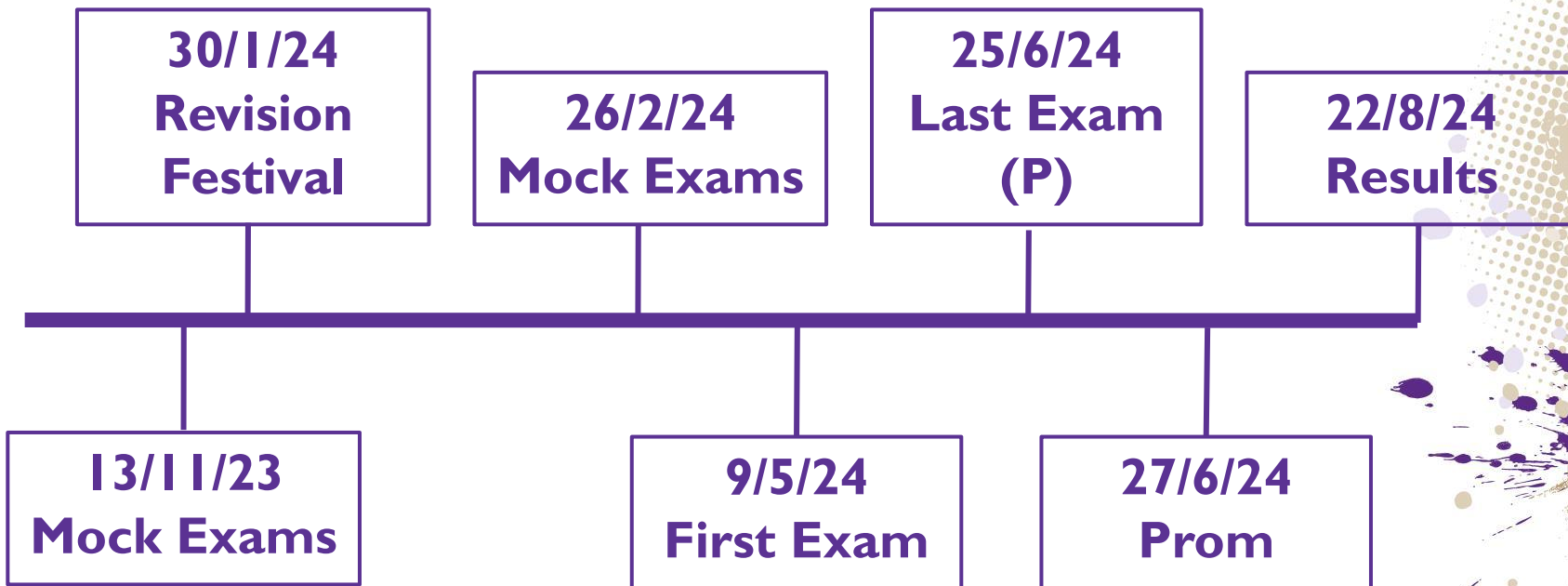


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Year 11 Timeline

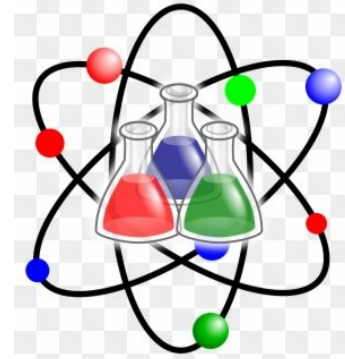

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English: What are we doing for your child?

English Language:

- Two papers - fiction reading and creative writing, non-fiction reading and transactional writing
- 50% reading, 50% writing

English Literature:

- Two papers - Shakespeare and Anthology Poetry
- An Inspector Calls, A Christmas Carol and Unseen Poetry
- all equally weighted = 20% of GCSE

What support do we offer your child in school?

- Core English 5HPW with experts
- After-school English
- 1:1 or small group sessions
- Form time support, as appropriate
- Revision materials produced by Heads of English and English directors

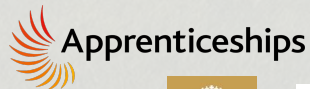
