Outwood Grange Academy's careers programme is committed to developing a whole school approach in providing every student with up to date, impartial, independent and varied careers education, information, advice and guidance defined by the CDI framework and Gatsby standards. The Academy works in partnership with Progress Careers, an external, independent and impartial careers guidance service.
