## **Partial School Closure - Year 9: COVID-19 Pandemic**

I hope you are well.

Unfortunately we have a significant number of staff absences. As a result I have made the decision to close the Academy for all of Year 9, for 3 days from Wednesday 30 March 2022, as we cannot staff their lessons and keep students safe. Finding staff from agencies is also incredibly difficult and often we cannot get supply teachers in.

**The Academy will be closed to all Year 9 students from Wednesday 30 March 2022 to Friday 1 April 2022 inclusive. Year 9 students will return on Monday 4 April 2022 .**

## **Home Learning**

We have previously communicated with you to explain what the process will be for setting work for students during the enforced closure. Therefore, whilst at home, Google Classroom is the means by which teachers will set work for their classes. In order for parents/carers to support their children at home, we have created a [Home Learning webpage](http://homelearning.outwood.com) (homelearning.outwood.com) which provides you with guidance on how to access Google Classroom with your child.

Lessons will be available for all subjects and the timings of each lesson will follow the school day. For each lesson there will be work and resources uploaded to Google Classroom. The independent work which they will then complete at home should be submitted to their usual teacher via Google Classroom.
